¿What are alternative courts/programs? The alternative courts/programs are an alternative to criminal prosecution and if completed satisfactorily, the charges related to the case before the court will be dismissed. Alternative courts/programs aim to reduce

crime and increase public safety by providing appropriate treatment and support.

¿Is my case eligible for an alternative court/program?

You should talk to your lawyer right away and ask them if your case is eligible. Cases should be referred to these programs early on and it may take time to screen your case.
